- e) Possible location system for events. All events would require a postcode, then the site could have a map showing them all. Perhaps a 'Rotherham' section?

4. The "Look" of the website

Needs more photos! - Header background image (not font or colour scheme) and nav might be worth updating.

5. Recruitment

Agreed people joining the committee ought to be friends of friends rather than open to the general masses. - Possibility of a photographer (Trevor's contact Kevin?) joining the team, although not necessarily as a full committee member.

6. Policy

Nkululeko can get hold of a co-op policy (cut and paste boilerplate).

7/8. Publicity and Funding

Trevor will meet with the Sharrow committee, suggesting a joint fundraiser (in 2014) - possibly linking into Peace in the Park. It will likely require some volunteer help.

A typical fundraising event such as a Sunday afternoon band and DJ can be expected to raise £100-200 and also be useful for publicity (leaflets, merchandise, etc. - perhaps make badges/business cards/stickers..? It would require volunteers to help set up and staff the door.
